- I understand that I am registering my child to participate in the Howard County Junior High School Gifted and Talented Chorus and as such, <u>I am making a primary commitment that my</u> <u>student will attend ALL rehearsals and the concert for their full duration. Tardiness will not be</u> <u>tolerated.</u>
- I understand that it is the responsibility of the parent / guardian to transport their child to and from rehearsals. Parents/Guardians are responsible for providing transportation to and from the concert.

I understand that my child must be at rehearsals on time and picked up on time.

Attendance at all rehearsals and performances is mandatory. Students must be present on time at all rehearsals. Tardiness will be considered an unexcused absence. Please compare the G/T Chorus schedule with your calendar to work out conflicts. In *extreme* circumstances, students may request an excused absence.

Excused absences will be granted at the discretion of the G/T Chorus Coordinators. Acceptable reasons might include, but are not limited to: extenuating circumstances (wedding, funeral), athletic game conflict, extreme illness, etc... Excused absences will not include reasons such as work, athletic practice, homework, etc... Students must contact the G/T Chorus Coordinators one week prior to the missed rehearsal to be considered for an excused absence. Students may be permitted only one excused absence. Students may be denied the request for an excused absence. More than one absence from the Tuesday night rehearsals will result in dismissal from the ensemble.

 Students selected are expected to participate and to come prepared for each rehearsal (binder, music, pencil) and understand that the <u>HCPSS code of conduct is in effect at all times.</u>
 Students selected will pay a \$100 fee to cover costs of the music and accompanist. <u>Cash or</u> <u>checks made payable to <i>HCPSS</i> are due at the first rehearsal on September 21</u> . If this fee presents significant hardship for your family, please speak directly to your school choir director. This fee is non-refundable.
 The Directors have the right to dismiss any student from the ensemble at any time at their discretion.
 I understand that all rehearsals will follow CDC/HCPSS policies for Covid-19 and that those policies may change over the next six months.
